

2023 PCIA RFI Market Notice

PG&E is pleased to announce the issuance of its Power Charge Indifference Adjustment (“PCIA”) Request for Information (“RFI”) in accordance with the California Public Utilities Commission Decision (D.) [21-05-030](#) (Ordering Paragraph 6). D. 22-12-030 addressing PG&E’s 2022 [Renewable Portfolio Standard \(RPS\) Plan](#) approved the substance of PG&E’s 2023 PCIA RFI proposal.

PG&E is seeking interest from counterparties of its PCIA-eligible RPS contracts (“Counterparty”) for any of the following:

- Contract termination: PG&E will offer a buyout of the contract
- Contract assignment: PG&E will connect Counterparties to third-party buyers and offer a buyout of the contract if a Counterparty can recontract with a third-party buyer
- Other contract modifications

Counterparties may submit Proposals for any combination of the above options. PG&E will consider Proposals that provide a clear benefit to its customers in reducing costs.

PG&E requests interested Counterparties submit a cover letter with the following information (“Proposal”):

- Contract log number(s).
- Describe in detail the commercial arrangement proposed.
- Advantages to PG&E. Please attach supporting analysis, including any quantitative analysis.
- Counterparty’s acceptance of the General Terms and Conditions.
