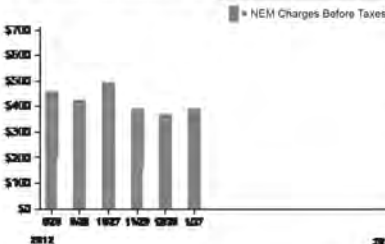

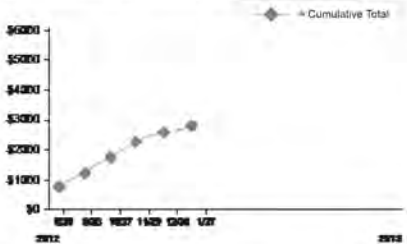

Cumulative NEM Balance

Cumulative NEM balance is a running total of your electricity costs and can increase or decrease depending on each month's use and generation. You only pay your Cumulative NEM balance at True-Up.
