QUESTION 02

- a) Is KDF still engaged with PG&E to perform EVM work?
- b) Is KDF currently engaged with PG&E as a contractor for any work other than EVM?

ANSWER 02

- a) Yes, KDF is still engaged with PG&E to perform EVM work, although currently they are on vacation leave.
- b) Yes, KDF is engaged with PG&E as a contractor to perform a variety of vegetation management work, other than EVM, within PG&E's North Coast region.
