The following questions relate to the article *Humboldt County Issues Stop Work Order, PG&E Removes Contractor on EVM in Sohum After Complaints/Video by Residents*, published in Redheaded Blackbelt on December 16, 2021 (the article).¹ This article describes activities performed by a contractor allegedly performing EVM work for PG&E in Humboldt County.

QUESTION 01

The article alleges that a contractor, KDF, was performing EVM work for PG&E in Humboldt County, on Thomas Road in the Salmon Creek watershed, on or around December 16, 2021.
